



## **SASOL INVITES INTERESTED PARTIES TO PARTNER FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF ASH BENEFICIATION TECHNOLOGIES AT ITS SOUTH AFRICAN OPERATIONS IN SECUNDA**

Sasol is committed to reducing its overall impact on the environment and is developing and implementing various projects and initiatives to enable long-term benefits for the company through an updated strategy. Sasol is currently exploring different initiatives and projects with the intent of enabling technology development deployment to achieve large-scale ash stock pile reduction in Secunda. Ash Beneficiation has been identified as a promising lever to reduce the build-up of ash and has the potential to develop new industries through ash beneficiation.

Sasol is inviting interested parties to participate in a Request for Information (RFI) process regarding the development and demonstration of ash beneficiation technologies and solutions. The closing date for submissions is 30 October 2021.

The intent of this RFI is to identify respondents making use of technology to process large volumes on fresh and weather ash streams. The scale of application for potential projects can range from demonstration level to commercial level and is not limited to aggregate manufacturing for brick and block making.
